



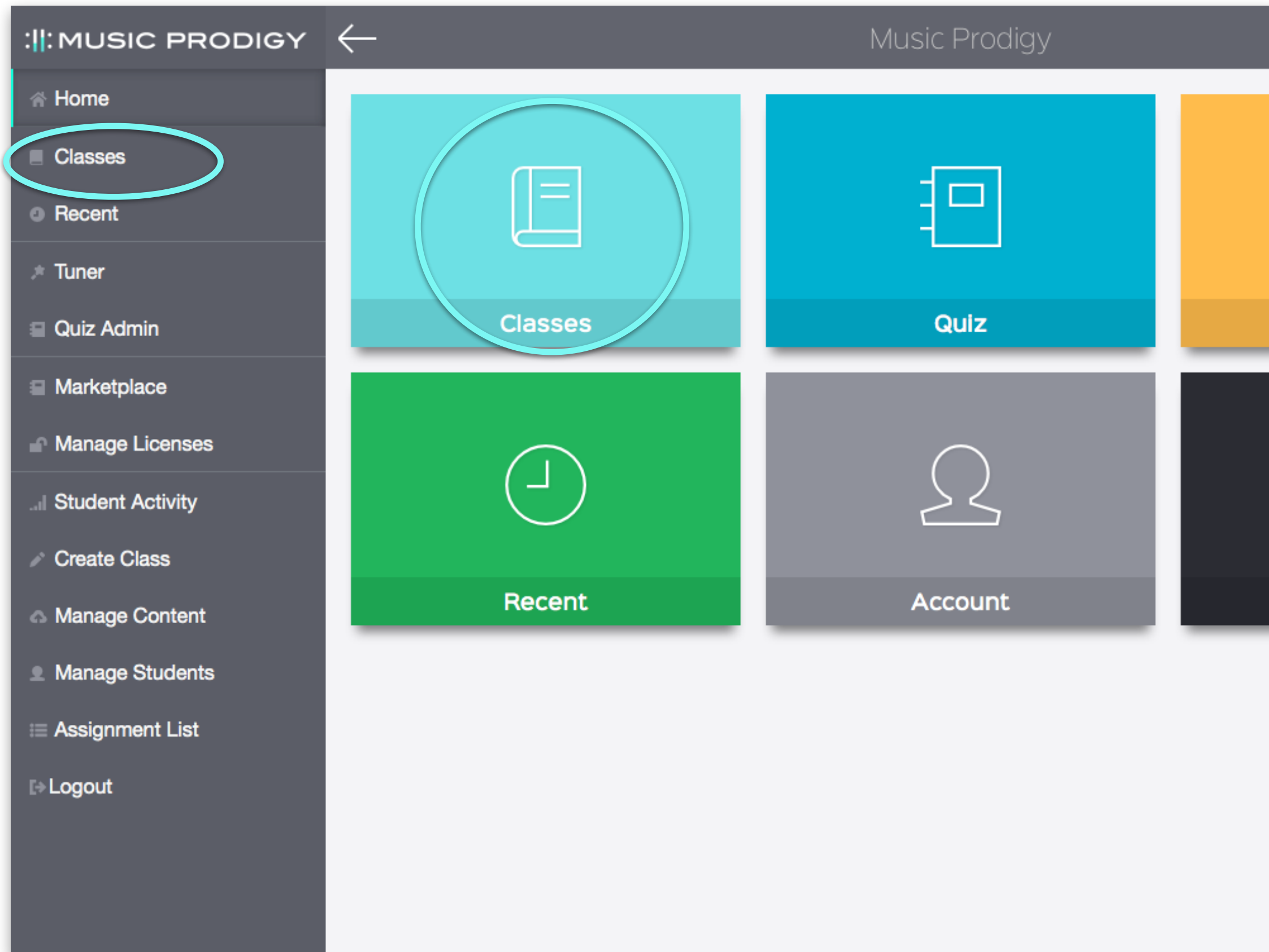
How Teachers Invite Students to Classes

Music Prodigy offers two options to add students to classes.

Option 1: Inviting students using class codes

Step 1:

Click on the main menu and select Classes or click on Classes from the home screen.




Option 1 (cont'd) Step 2:

On the Classes screen each class has a corresponding class code.

The class code can be shared with students.

Students enter the class code to enroll themselves in the class.

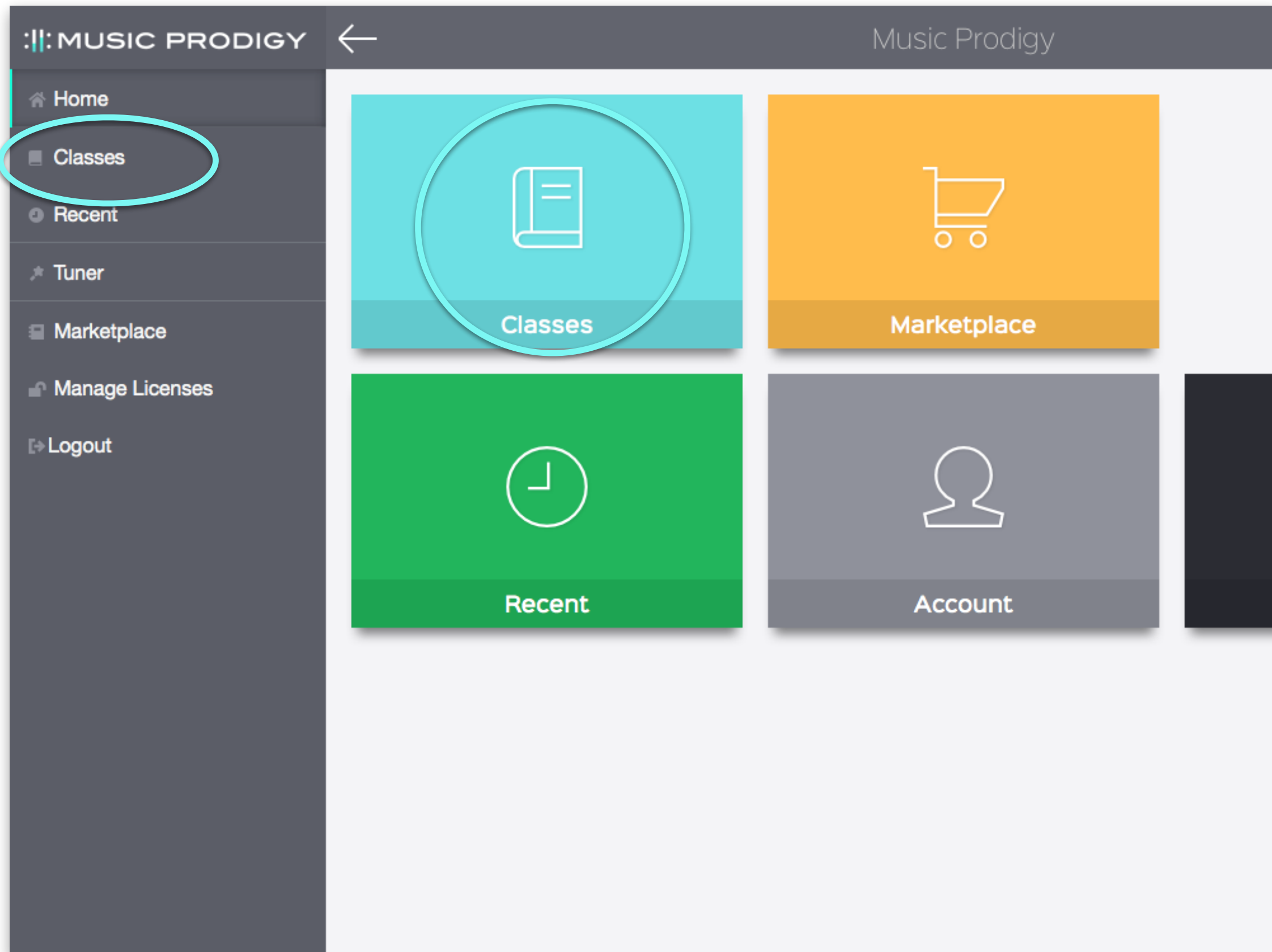



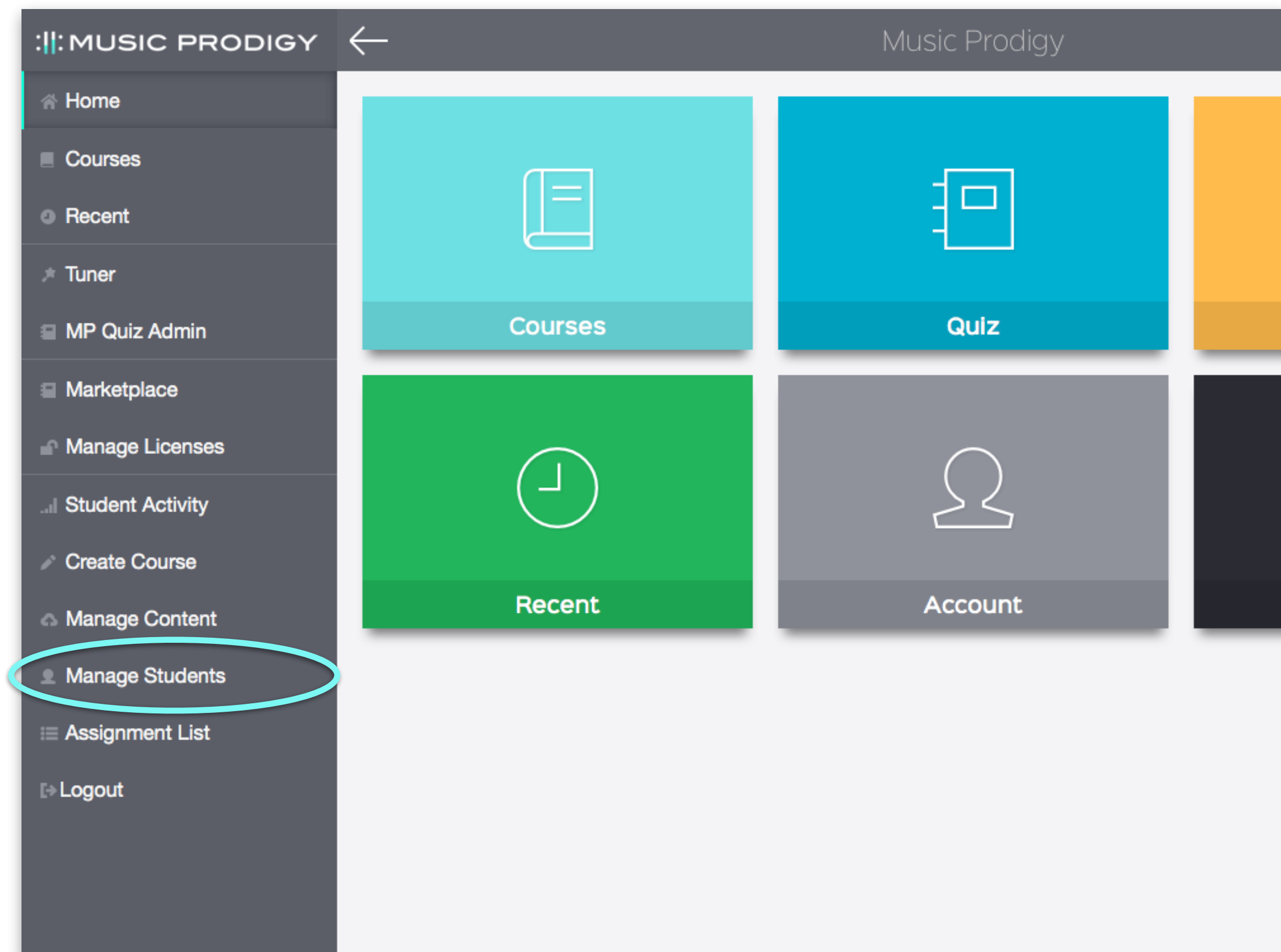
